Party nominees from the May 3, 2022, Primary Election

Party nominees from the May Primaries and Independent candidates will also appear on the General ballot.

- First day to issue a petition- **February 7, 2022 (for those that did not qualify in for the May Primary Election)**
- Deadline to turn in petition- **April 7, 2022, 12:00 NOON** - Those seeking the offices for the 9th Judicial District will also have to file required paperwork in Meigs, Morgan and Roane Counties by this deadline.
- First day to request an absentee ballot by Military or Overseas voter- **January 1, 2022**
- First day to request an absentee ballot –**May 6, 2022** (Non-Military or Overseas voter)
- Last day to request and process an absentee ballot- **July 28, 2022**
- Last day to register to vote- **July 5, 2022**
- Early voting dates- **July 15-July 30, 2022**
